## POLICY

*Smoking on board is only allowed in designated smoking areas.*

*Under certain operations smoking is prohibited everywhere outside of the accommodation, including, but not limited to:*

- *Vessel being inside the 500m safety zones of an installation.*
- *Bunker operations or any other operations involving flammable substances*
- *Any other situation where there may be a risk of flammable substances on deck*

*It is the duty of any person on board to use his or her STOP WORK authority to temporary order smoking stop if there is a suspicion that smoking may represent an unacceptable fire risk.*

*The Captain shall prohibit smoking completely or in certain areas, if he or she considers the HSEQ risks to be unacceptable.*

*Violations to the smoking policy shall be reported as a nonconformity.*

## GUIDANCE ON THE DESIGNATION OF SMOKING AREAS

The Master shall ensure that there are designated smoking areas on board. These shall not include the Bridge, cabins, Engine Control Room, Crane cabins or in switchboard rooms.

Smoking areas inside the accommodation shall be in specially designated smoking day-rooms. There shall be no inside smoking areas on the tugs.

Examples of smoking areas outside may be the bridge wings and the forecastle.

Dedicated area in the engine room may be the Engine workshop or other areas with proper ventilation
